

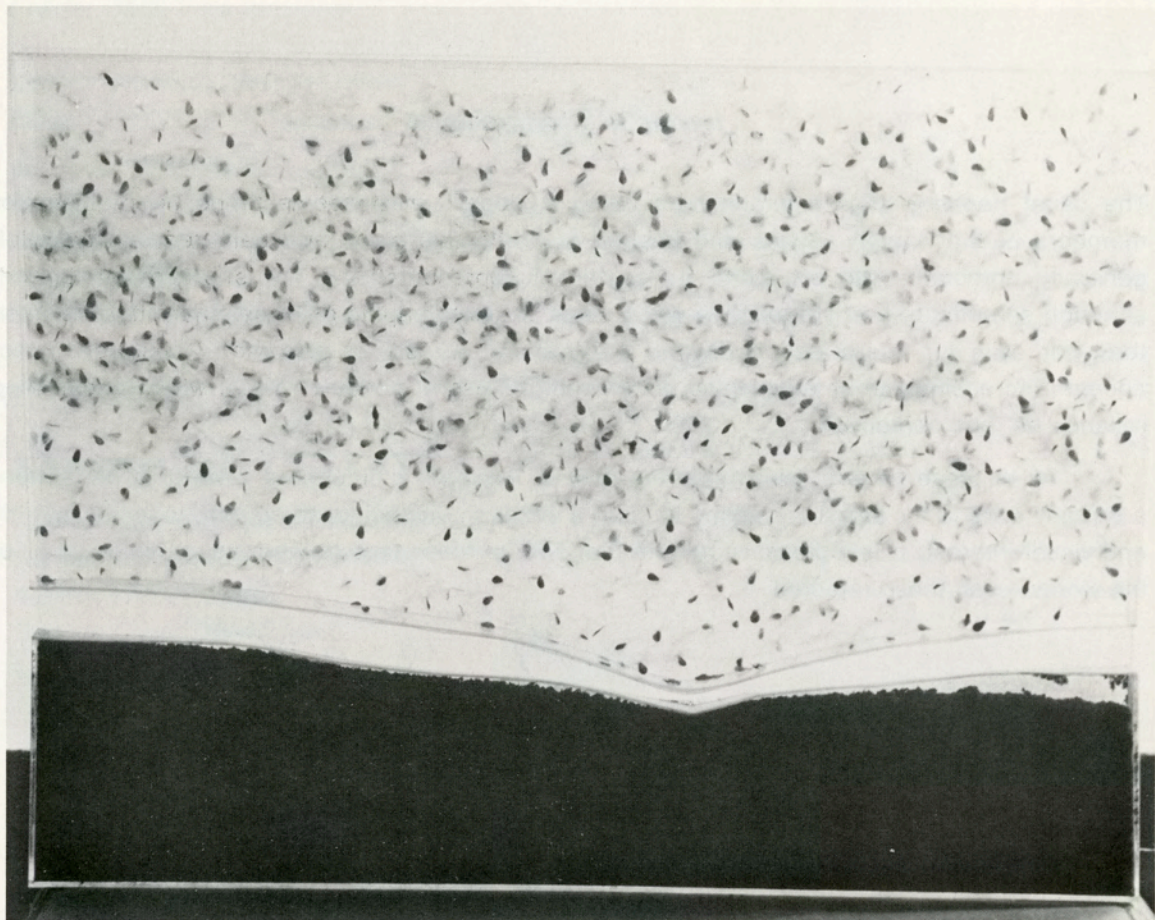
Juror's Statement

The usual negative stigma attached to being a "local" artist seems to be no problem for members of the Society. Styles and images are reflective of an amalgamated quality which generally dominates the art world as a whole. Representational art is predominant, and, although sometimes overly seductive when taken to photographic extremes, here it more often than not calls for interpretation beyond the surface. As is true elsewhere, abstraction too, appears increasingly to be enveloping once again the use of personal vision, with a diminishing reliance on total objectivity.

All of these factors have made the task of jurying a difficult and rewarding one. There are many criteria for decision making in such a situation, including, of course, technical quality and visual interest. It is a pleasure to note that both of these factors were quite evident in all of the works, even those rejected.

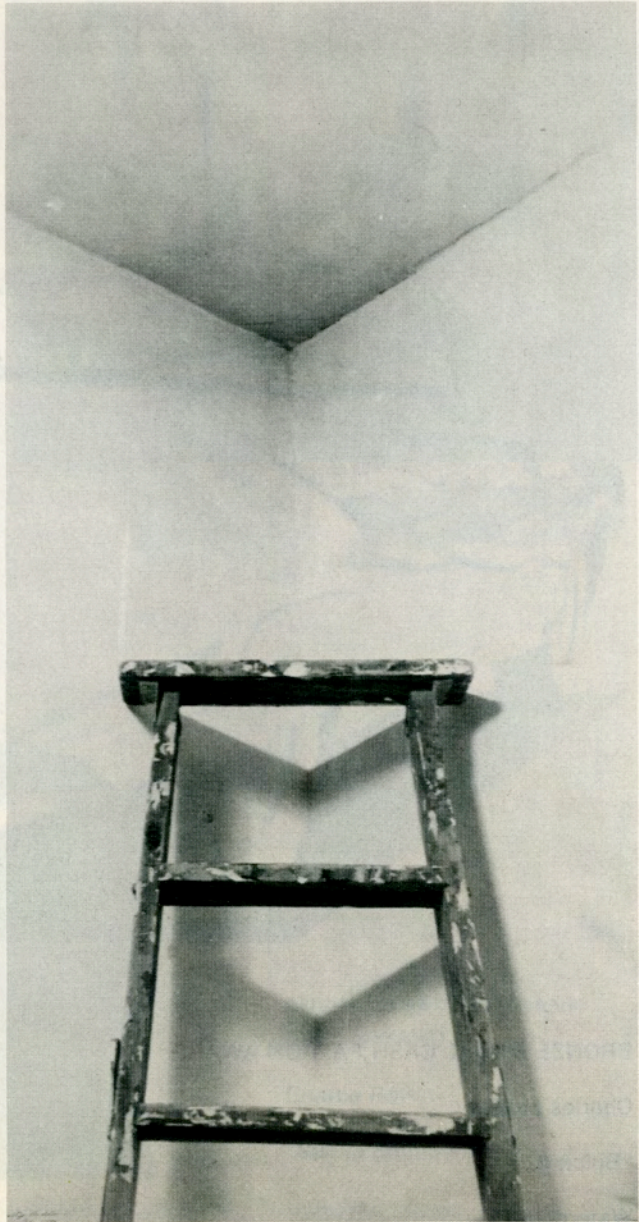
